THE COMPANY:

THE FARM:

Nova Harvest Ltd., in partnership with Huu-ay-aht Group of Businesses (HGB), has embarked on a multi-year project to improve the sustainability of the shellfish aquaculture industry by building, modifying, adapting and designing automated processes for oyster aquaculture. Together Nova and HGB have created a scalable, efficient oyster farming business and look to increase sustainable seafood production in the Barkley Sound.

As we continue to develop our shellfish tenures within Barkley Sound, we are looking for individuals who are not afraid to try and do things differently as we continually improve and refine our farm process together. We view future success in shellfish aquaculture will come through innovation and this is the core of our decisions making.

THE JOB:

A typical day starts with a boat ride to the farm, located approximately 10 minutes away from Bamfield. You'll spend 8-10 hours at the farm, operating semi-automated, modernized, oyster handling equipment, cleaning, and maintaining equipment. The work will be both physically and mentally demanding, requiring teamwork, flexibility, and adaptability in a dynamic environment.

Reporting to the Oyster Farm Manager, the Oyster Farm Operator will:

- Participate in the production, harvest, processing, and shipment of oysters.
- Assist in the construction, troubleshooting, and maintenance of farm equipment, including boats.
- Perform equipment cleaning and general maintenance of the farm.
- Monitor environmental and product growth and maintain daily records.
